CONDITIONS

1. Every entry shall constitute an agreement that the person making it shall be subject to the rules and regulations of the Bryn Mawr Hound Show Committee. The decision of the Committee on all questions arising there from shall be final. In the case of differences between Prize List and Show Catalogue, the Catalogue supersedes. The Committee, at its sole discretion, reserves the right to refuse any entry.
2. All hounds entered for competition must be in their kennels in the show yard by one-half hour before the commencement of judging. ***All divisions shall begin judging promptly at 8:30 a.m.*** Kennels must be vacated by noon on the day following the show. Transportation is not available.
3. A master by making entries in this show thereby certifies that the entries shown in the unentered classes are hounds whelped after the first of December two years prior to the current year which are fully intended to be entered hounds at the proper time, and that hounds in entered classes are hunted in a regular and systematic manner. All unentered hounds must be listed under the name of the hunt that is showing them.
4. EACH HUNT MAY SHOW THREE (3) ENTRIES PER CLASS. A MAXIMUM OF FIVE (5) ENTRIES PER CLASS MAY BE SUBMITTED, ANY THREE (3) OF WHICH MAY BE SHOWN. **Entries not shown MUST be scratched with the appropriate Breed Steward at the Secretary's tent at least fifteen (15) minutes prior to the start of the Show.** (Note that there will no longer be substitutions in any classes.)
5. No entry changes will be accepted less than 72 hours before the show.
6. **ENTRY AND KENNEL FEES.** The entry fee is \$10.00 **per entry to be shown**, except the pack class, which is \$20.00, however total entry fees are capped at \$150.00 per hunt. There is no entry fee for the junior handler classes. The kennel fee is \$25.00 per kennel. Entry and kennel fees are due and payable at the time of entry submission. Access to kennels prior to Friday may be arranged by contacting the Show Secretary.
7. All hounds must be named with date of entry for entered hounds, and name and date of entry for sire and dam, as they appear in the stud books of the Masters of Foxhounds Association, Penn-Marydel Foxhounds Inc., or the National Beagle Club. In the case of pack classes, individual hounds need not be named, but must meet criteria detailed in Condition 9.
8. In all rings, hounds may be shown on lead or loose at the option of the exhibitor but with the concurrence of the judge, provided however, that hounds shown loose are not to interfere with the showing of other hounds. Any hound so interfering shall be placed on a lead at the order of the Steward.
9. Entered foxhounds must have been accepted by the Keeper of the Stud Book of the Master of Foxhounds Association, Keeper of the Stud Book of the Penn-Marydel Foxhounds, Inc., subject to the conditions detailed in the Penn - Marydell section. Unentered foxhounds must be eligible by acceptance by same. In the case of pack classes, individual hounds need not be named.

CONDITIONS

10. In the English ring, foxhounds drafted from other hunts can be shown in all classes. In all other foxhound rings not excepted by the committee, foxhounds drafted from other hunts, with the exception of unentered hounds, can be shown only in the stallion hound or brood bitch classes. Drafted foxhounds from all rings, however, may participate in the Pack Class. Note that in the case of hunts which have totally disbanded and dispersed their hounds to other hunts, those hounds will not be considered draft hounds for the purposes of showing at the Bryn Mawr Hound Show.
11. Only winners of the unentered, entered, stallion and brood bitch classes are eligible for the champion class.
12. Champions of Record or a hound that has won a championship at a previous Bryn Mawr Hound Show may not compete in the entered dog or entered bitch class of its division. Bryn Mawr Champions of Record may compete in the stallion, brood bitch, stallion with get, brood bitch with produce **and the dog or bitch champion class of its division.** Entries must be made for these classes prior to the closing date.
13. A hound that is placed second in a class that qualifies the winner for a champion class may compete for the reserve champion at the discretion of the judge.
14. In the event of only one exhibiting pack entering a class, ribbons and trophies may be awarded but no points will be awarded towards the huntsman's prize. Unless there are three or more entries from two exhibiting packs in a class, no points will be awarded towards the huntsman's prize to second place exhibitors, but ribbons may be awarded.
15. There shall be no post entries or substitutions in any class. All hounds must be entered on the entry form. In the pack class, the individual hounds need not be named. In the stallion with get, bitch with produce and two couple hounds classes, the hounds must be named.
16. Hunt personnel shall wear kennel coats except in pack class where hunt livery is required. Hunt personnel showing packs are limited to a huntsman and one whipper-in.
17. Huntsman cash prizes of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) first and fifty dollars (\$50.00) for second shall be given to the huntsman of each hound division winning the most "points" in Competition. No "points" will be awarded to hounds removed from the judging area prior to being excused by the judge.

18. To be eligible for a huntsman's prize, exhibitors must show in the pack class. The huntsman's cash prize will be awarded following the pack class, the results of which will be included in the determination.
19. Livery is required for pack classes. Show management may waive this requirement no later than lunchtime in the event of an excessive heat index.

MISCELLANEOUS

ONLINE ENTRY FORMS must be completed via the Bryn Mawr Hound website NO LATER THAN SUNDAY, May 5th, 2024.

No entry changes will be accepted less than 72 hours prior to the show.

The CONDITIONS will require study prior to completion of a class ENTRY FORM. In the event of conflicts between the Prize List and the Show Catalogue, the Show Catalogue will take precedence.

All entered Bassets and entered Beagles must list Hunt where *bred* as the prefix.

All entered Foxhounds must list the Hunt where *entered* as prefix.

The MFHA requires that any recognized or registered **foxhound** hunt that wishes to exhibit hounds in any of the sanctioned hound shows must pay the annual hound show and performance trial fee to the MFHA.

Beagle and Basset packs must be in compliance with N.B.C. rules.

No Dogs of any description will be permitted on the grounds the day prior to the show, the show itself, or the day following the show, unless it be a hound from an exhibiting pack. Bitches in heat or having whelped within 3 weeks of the show will not be permitted. All dogs must have age-appropriate shots meeting applicable local regulations.

Rings will be off limits on the day prior to the show.

NOTE: Kennels may be used by assigned packs only, subject to a Kennel Fee of \$25.00 per kennel. In the case of kennel over-subscription, the Committee reserves the right to limit each pack to 3 kennels. Exhibitors are reminded not to leave valuables unattended in kennels.

A Food truck will be available starting at 7:00 a.m. and ending at 2:00 p.m.

An Area Accommodation listing is provided at the end of the Prize List. Book early due to the concurrent Devon Horse Show.

A map to the Radnor grounds is attached to this document.

Unless specifically designated otherwise in this document, all trophies are the property of BMHS and are now perpetual. Winners of trophy classes may be required to sign a receipt upon taking possession of a trophy. Loss or damage to the trophies is not insured. Accordingly, any winner who chooses to take possession of a trophy assumes responsibility for its repair or replacement if it should be damaged, mis-laid, lost, or stolen. Please contact the Trophy Chairman - **Nancy Dougherty** at **610-207-5990** if you desire the appraised value of a trophy. Trophies must be cleaned, engraved, and returned to the trophy table prior to the start of the show. Packs will be billed for engraving on trophies returned unengraved. A perpetual trophy to be held one year by the winner.

CLASS 123. THE FIFTH MASTER OF FOXHOUNDS CHALLENGE CUP FOR ENGLISH HOUNDS

BEST FIVE COUPLE, either sex, or mixed, providing there are at least two entries in different interests.

The Sixth Cup returned to competition in 1966 by Mr. Stewart's Cheshire Foxhounds as a perpetual trophy to be held one year by winner.

Livery is required unless waived by Show Management due to an excessive heat index.

Packs will be judged against the following criteria:

Conformation-30%	Uniformity-30%
Biddability-30%	Appointments-10%

AMERICAN FOXHOUNDS

All American Foxhound entries are limited to hounds registered in the Stud Book of the Masters of Foxhounds Association of America with a Breed Coefficient of 7 or less. This rule does not apply to unentered hounds eligible for registration.

Hounds with more than 1/16 but less than or equal to 1/8 outcross are eligible to show in 7/8 Bred (Listed) classes 203 or 211. Listed class entries do not qualify for Championship classes.
